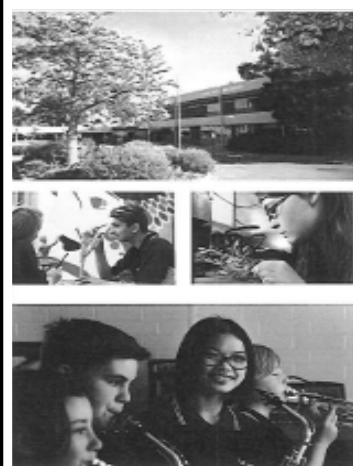

The 2018 School Card Application can now be done 'online'. Once completed, the form will be emailed directly to the school your child attends, i.e. where two children attend different schools both sites will receive a copy of the application form. We encourage all families who have a Centrelink card to fill out an application form as soon as possible. You can also come into the school and fill out a paper copy.

Eligibility for School Card assistance is dependent upon the combined family gross income from the 2016 - 2017 financial year being within the following School Card income limits:

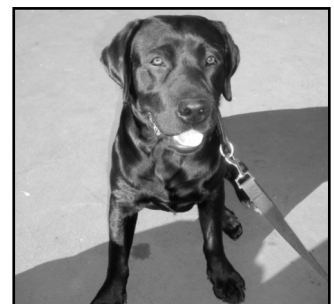
## Bentley News

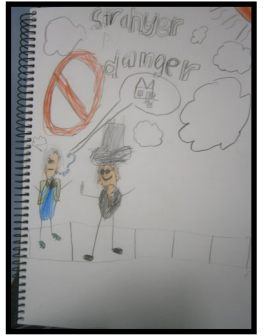
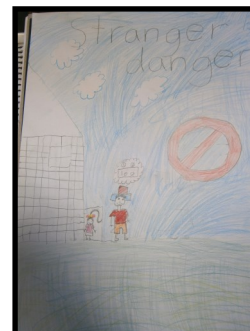
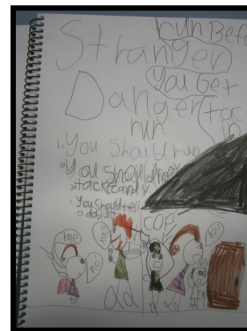
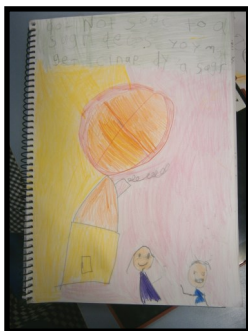
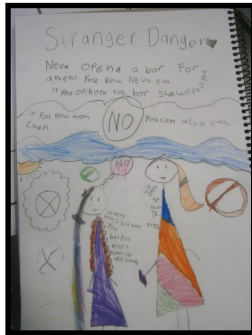




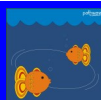
# Stranger Danger

## Room 7

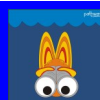
