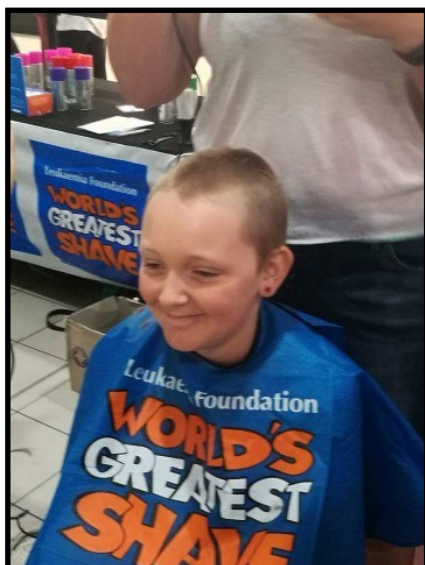


WORLDS GREATEST SHAVE

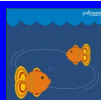

We are very proud of her efforts.

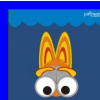
