Principal's Message

Planning for 2024

Teachers will start working on class placements for 2024 at the beginning of next term. I would like to invite families to speak with your child's teacher or make a time to speak with leadership if you would like to discuss this with us. We do not accept requests for certain teachers or friends however, we are happy to talk to you about the process.

Teachers take the following aspects of students learning and development into consideration during this process:

- Social and emotional development
- Wellbeing and student agency
- Learning environments that optimise student learning
- Class placement and access to different learning environments
- Opportunities for challenge and intervention

This is a complex task and many individual and whole school aspects are taken into consideration. At times we have had families ask about composite classes. There are many reasons we have composite classes. We would like to re-assure families that all students are stretched and supported in all areas of their learning. Composite classes do not have a negative effect on this.

Teacher placement is also a complex task and we don't always complete these placements until the last minute. All teachers at Northfield are highly skilled and dedicated to all students.

On the completion of class placement for 2024 we will not be moving any students due to family requests. A lot of discussion, thinking and planning goes into the placement of every child before class lists are finalised.

Principal's Message

Our classes are funded on student numbers and this impacts staffing. If you are planning on moving out of the area can you please see Cindy for an exit form. This will give us information about our enrolment numbers and how many classes we will be funded for.

Keeping our school and community safe during school holidays




